# Coffee Cup Cozy

Pattern by Karen JCrochets

#### <u>Materials</u>

G Hook

Worsted weight yarn, any color

Scissors

Tape Measure (There are great retractable tapes available at Hobby Lobyy!)

Button

Needle

Thread

#### <u>Abbreviations</u>

Ch: Chain

Hdc: Double crochet

Sc: Single crochet

St(s): Stitch(es)

SI st: Slip stitch

Sp: Space

## Measuring



Not all coffee cups are created equal If you want a good fit, I would highly suggest taking a few seconds before you get started to take a couple of measurements



First, you will need to measure the circumference of the cup. All the way around the outside of the cup. My cup measured approximately 10 3/4 inches.



Next, measure how tall your cup is. Mine measured 4 inches.

### Pattern



To Start: Ch 13, Hdc in second ch from the hook & across (12)

Now, at this point I take another quick second to double-check my work I have placed it on the cup to see if I have left enough of a "lip" on the cup to comfortably drink Personally, I don't like to feel the fuzzy yarn on my lips, nor do I want to leave any lipstick on my beautiful cozy.

Let's keep going...

Coffee Cup Cozy Continued...

Row I: Ch I, turn; Hdc across (12) Rows 2-36: Repeat row I



At this point, it's a good idea to stop & take another quick measurement. Since mugs come in different sizes, you want the length of your cozy to be about 34 of an inch to I inch shorter than the circumference of your cup. We will be making a tag of sorts to make up the different and reach through the thumb hole of our mug.

(I forgot to measure mine as I was going (oops), so I measured once I was done. Do as I say, not as I do.)

Row 37: Ch I, turn; SI st in frist 3 sts; Hdc in next 6 sts. (It's going to look a little wonky for a bit, but stay with me.)
Row 38: Ch I, turn; Hdc in each st across (6)

Rows 39-41: Repeat row 38.

Row 42: Ch I, turn; Hdc in first 2 sts, ch 2, sk next two sts, hdc in last two sts (This creates a button hole)

Row 43: Ch I, turn; Hdc in first st, Hdc 3 times in ch 2 sp, Hdc in next sts.

Do not fasten off!

Turn your work to the side and begin placing a single crochet in each stitch around the entire perimeter of the piece, placing two sc in each corner. Once you have worked your way around to your first sc, sl st in that first sc. Fasten off & weave in ends.

Next, you will need to attach your button to the wide end of your cozy using the needle & thread
