

Shell Scarf

Materials

G Hook

Any worsted weight yarn

Scissors

Abbreviations

Ch: Chain

Dc: Half double crochet

Sc: Single crochet

St(s): Stitch(es)

Sk: Skip

Stitch Notes

Shell Stitch: 2 dc, ch 1, 2 dc (in indicated stitch)

Pattern Notes

The sides of your scarf will be scalloped, not straight.

Pattern

To Start: Chain in a multiple of four. (I chained 16 for a more narrow scarf)

Row 1: Shell stitch in 4th ch from the hook; *Sk next 3 sts, shell st in the next st*; Repeat * to end of row.

Row 2: Ch 3, turn; *Shell st in ch 1 sp of shell*, Repeat * to end of row.

Rows 3+: Repeat row 2 to desired length

Fasten off & weave in ends
